Whereas, In pursuance of and according to Article IV, Section 3, of the Constitution of the National Society of the SONS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION, and also in accordance with Article VIII of the Constitution of the Pennsylvania Society of the SONS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION, you have made application to the Board of Managers of said State Society for authority to form a Chapter, to be called and known as Pittsburgh Chapter to be located at Pittsburgh, in the County of Allegheny and of which you are to be members; and
